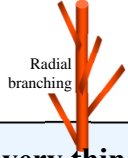


SOUTHERN AUSTRALIAN SPECIES OF BRYOPSIS AT A GLANCE

I. branching pattern mainly radial



Ia. Ultimate branches (ramuli) very thin (20-35µm across)



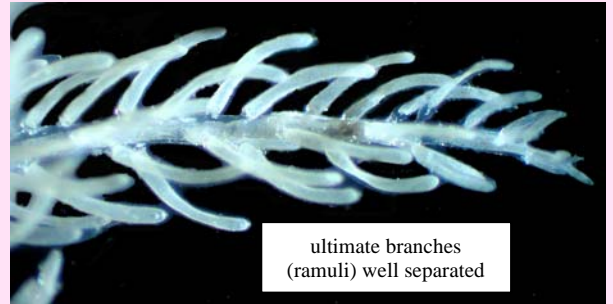
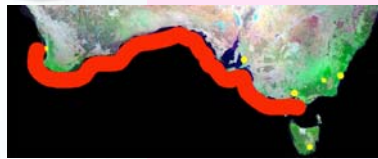
Bryopsis minor

Ib. Ultimate branches (ramuli) thicker (> 70µm across)

Bryopsis foliosa



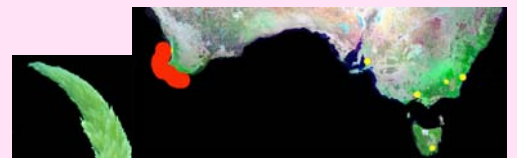
ultimate branches (ramuli) close together and curved



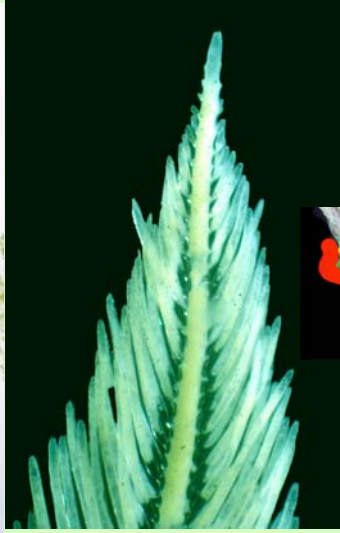
Bryopsis vestita



ultimate branches (ramuli) close together and straight



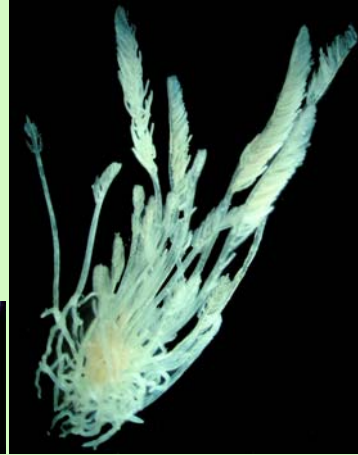
II. branching pattern mainly two-sided (pinnate) (occasionally one-sided)
